OVERVIEW

The Texas Heart Institute Cardiac Society presents its eighth symposium. This year the Society has partnered with Baylor College of Medicine to sponsor the first Igor F. Palacios, MD, Distinguished Lectureship in Cardiology.

The meeting hopes to provide members of the Texas Heart Institute Cardiac Society and other health professionals involved in cardiovascular care with an educational experience that is comprehensive and yet concentrated in a practical one-day format. The activity is a full-day program exploring the management and treatment of patients with structural, coronary, peripheral vascular, and electrophysiologic diseases, congestive heart failure, and risk factor management. This course includes lectures, interactive and dynamic case presentations from leaders in each field, and the opportunity to interact with these leaders in an intimate meeting format.

ACCREDITATION
